

## Evacuation via Alfalfa Field to Patterson Lake Road

If you must evacuate Pine Forest, your first choice is to exit the main entry onto Elbow Coulee Road.

**IF THE MAIN ENTRY IS BLOCKED**, you can exit through the alfalfa field south of Patterson Lake to Patterson Lake Road.

Drive north on North Blackjack Road alongside the pond. Don't turn on any road or driveway until you reach the road end with the open alfalfa field at the right.

**1.** Follow the flagged stakes along the North Blackjack evacuation route to the alfalfa field to Patterson Lake Road.

Intersections are staked to guide you.



**2.** At the end of North Blackjack, on the right, there's a gate to the field.

Drive through the gate, turn sharp right and head south, keeping the haystacks to your right.

Drive to the end of the field and turn left, following the edge of the mowed field.



**3.** The irrigation sprinklers may still be watering.

Watch out for the pivoting sprinkler arm.

There are narrow ditches made by the irrigator wheels.

**Look for the double stakes and drive left of the ditches.**

All-wheel drive cars will make it fine; a Prius may get stuck.



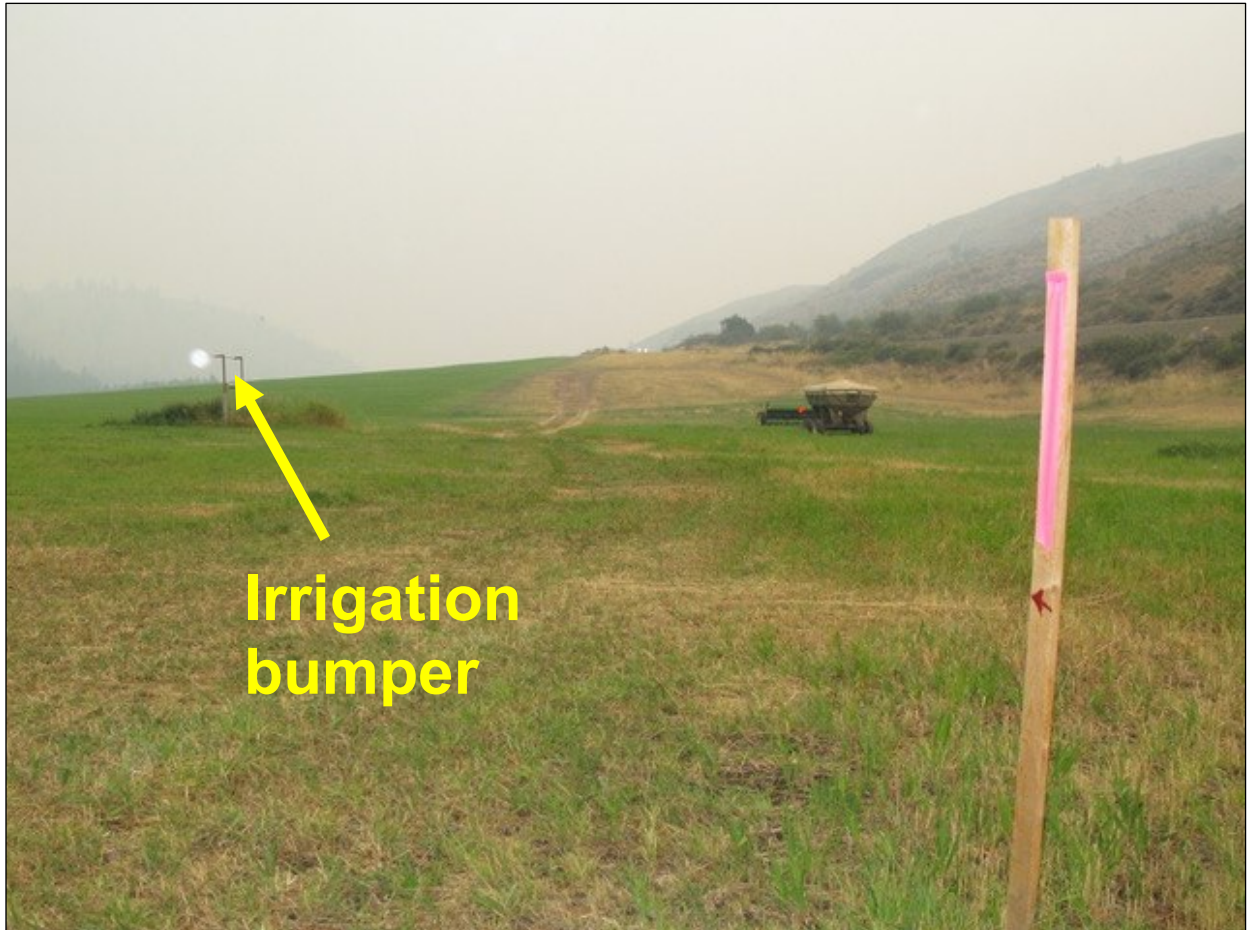
**4.** Follow the stakes around the corner to the right, along the edge of the mowed field.

The route gradually turns left.

Keep the irrigation bumper on your left.

Find the two-track road that heads north and uphill, then exits onto Patterson Lake Road.

Turn right to head into town, left to Sun Mountain Lodge.



Evacuation stakes are stored in the pumphouse near the alfalfa field.
