**As Neighbors, when one of these suggestions seems to have been “forgotten”,
let’s start by talking with each other in a neighborly way.**

1. Outdoor burning: Call Pine Forest management before doing any outdoor burning

2. Outdoor barbeques: Use extreme caution during fire season. Keep a hose nearby.
3. Fireworks: Absolutely no fireworks at any time.
4. Fire extinguishers: Have one with easy access.
5. Dogs: Pine Forest is pet friendly and we expect dogs to have good manners. Your dog’s persistent barking is not good manners, particularly when you are not home to hear it. Nor is jumping on walkers or cyclists a form of good manners.
6. Ambient light: Please turn off all outside lights before retiring at night or leaving your home for an extended time. Try to eliminate unnecessary light pollution by limiting extended lighting by timers.
7. Garbage: Dispose of regularly or it can attract bears.
8. Traffic: Yield to downhill traffic, especially in the winter when roads may be icy.
9. Water: Shut off water valves in your home, including the hot water heater valve, before leaving for an extended time.
10. Electricity: The electric coop suggests turning off the breaker to your hot water heater before leaving for an extended time, in order to prevent potential fire or flooding. The coop also recommends having a surge protector installed at your meter. Call the coop or a local electrician for information.
11. Hunting: Hunting is prohibited within Pine Forest.
12. Snowmobiling: Snowmobiling is prohibited on Pine Forest roads.
